The HSE has a responsibility under Children First legalisation to ensure that <u>all</u> staff members (permanent, temporary, agency, locum or visiting), students and volunteers, irrespective of role or grade are aware of how to recognise signs of child abuse or neglect and how to make a report Tusla - Child and Family Agency.

Children First: National Guidance for the Protection and Welfare of Children (2017) is the National Guidance which promotes the safety and well-being of all children. Children First states that "protecting children from harm is everyone's responsibility".
