CISM eLearning Stress Awareness Training for Cardiac First Responders

To assist Responders and emergency service personnel, PHECC in partnership with the NAS, has developed the first eLearning module on critical incident stress awareness training.

The module consists of a combination of expert presenters, bespoke video clips and interactive content. It is available free to all Responders, PHECC registered practitioners and NAS personnel who are not engaged in frontline service delivery. There are plans to also roll out to other services.
